<sup>6</sup> Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, <sup>7</sup> rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.



- how important are \_\_\_\_\_\_ to a plant?
- They are very important!
- on a blog called "easytogrowbulbs.com" the author explains the importance of roots in plants!

  I get funny looks when I shop at the garden center. I think it is when I tip the plant out of its pot to get a good look at the roots before I decide which to buy. But this is absolutely key to determining the health and vitality of the plant for sale. Disregard the lush top growth and number of flowers. To evaluate the health and long term performance of a plant it is all about the roots.

The roots of a plant have several important functions. The roots anchor the plant in place, resisting the forces of wind and running water or mud flow. The root system takes in oxygen, water and nutrients from the soil, to move them up through the plant to the stems, leaves and blooms. Roots often store the energies created by the plant through photosynthesis, to make them available to the plant as it is needed. Plant roots also stimulate and support microorganisms in the soil that benefit plant life.

- to make things simple for everyone who does not care about plants or gardening, the roots are essential for plant and health!
- in this passage we hear about being and established in Jesus - how important is it to be rooted in Jesus Christ as a Christian? - Absolutely essential
- Paul later comments about the importance of being connected or in Jesus Christ in Colossians 2
Colossians 2:19 and not holding fast to the Head, from whom the whole body, nourished and together through its joints and ligaments, with a growth that is from God.
- when we are not connected or rooted in Christ we will never  - if we are not in Christ, and buy into dangerous earthly ideas, we metaphorically wither
