


Sardis – Revelation 3:1-6 The Dead Church

Revelation 3:1-6 ESV

¹ "And to the angel of the church in Sardis write: 'The words of him who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars.

"'I know your works. You have the reputation of being alive, but you are dead. ² Wake up, and strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have not found your works complete in the sight of my God. ³ Remember, then, what you received and heard. Keep it, and repent. If you will not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come against you. ⁴ Yet you have still a few names in Sardis, people who have not soiled their garments, and they will walk with me in white, for they are worthy. ⁵ The one who conquers will be clothed thus in white garments, and I will never blot his name out of the book of life. I will confess his name before my Father and before his angels. ⁶ He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.'



Introduction and Background

- I had a serious mind blow when I read this article posted by Christianitytoday.com entitled, "More than a third of senior pastors believe 'good people' can earn their way to Heaven"

At least a third of senior pastors in the United States believe one can earn a place in Heaven by simply being a good person, according to a nationwide survey.

The <u>findings</u> were among several surprising responses as part of a <u>survey</u> conducted earlier this year by the <u>Cultural Research Center</u> at Arizona Christian University.

The American Worldview Inventory 2022 examined more than three dozen beliefs held by pastors. Researchers found that in addition to believing that people can merit salvation based solely on their good works, one-third or more of senior pastors surveyed also believe the Holy Spirit is not a person but rather "a symbol of God's power." Others said that moral truth is subjective; sexual relations between two unmarried people who love each other is "morally acceptable" and biblical teaching on abortion is "ambiguous."

After data reported earlier this year <u>found</u> just 37% of Christian pastors have a biblical worldview, the latest CRC report analyzed that research across all major U.S. denominations, and found that a "loss of biblical belief is prevalent among pastors in all denominational groupings."

- although this is an American survey, I would guess that the Canadian landscape of the church is much, much worse because we as a nation, are more progressive and have less Christian influence
- the North American church appears to be alive, but judging by this survey it is dead
- when 1/3 of pastors do not understand salvation (they have embraced salvation by works) and they do not understand God (they do not see the Holy Spirit as a person) then these pastors are dead
- this might seem judgmental to some but we need to ask how can someone be a Christian when they flat our reject basic Christian doctrine

we are seeing this in Canadian churches all the time, they might sing Christian hymns and read from the Bible but they do not those hymns and do not believe the Bible keep us from such a disaster!
- this address written to Sardis is not just a to the churches who have seriously gone astray from Jesus Christ
- also this address directly to the churches who are committed congregations to lesus Christ
- this is a warning to the faithful church not to be but to be entirely committed to lesus Christ
