## The Christmas Message in the Four Gospels: **The Coming of Christ in Matthew**

<sup>18</sup> Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. 19 And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. <sup>20</sup> But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. <sup>21</sup> She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." 22 All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: <sup>23</sup> "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son,

and they shall call his name Immanuel"

(which means, God with us). 24 When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, 25 but knew her not until she had given birth to a son. And he called his name Jesus.

1) Jesus is the Son of David
- the gospel of Matthew establishes very clearly that Jesus is the King of Israel in the line of David
- Jesus fulfills the promise given to David all the way back in the book of 2 Samuel - God promises that the family of David will always be on the of Israel 2 Samuel 7:13 He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.
- the first verse in the gospel of Matthew says that Jesus is from the family tree of David and thus according to Jewish tradition Jesus is a " of David" Matthew 1:1 The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.
<ul> <li>- you might wonder why would start out his gospel with the family tree of Jesus going back to Abraham</li> <li>- the North American family culture has become very fractured</li> <li>- just by way of example how many relatives do you want to remove from your family tree?</li> </ul>
- we all have that relative that has been twice removed
- but in Jewish culture the family was important and the family tree was important
- it is important that we know that Jesus is from the tree of Abraham and David so we can be confident that Jesus is rightfully the of Israel
- this is important because Matthew wants to the readers of his gospe that Jesus is the King of Israel and the Messiah
- also look at some of the names included in the family tree of Jesus in Matthew 1:1-
- there is Rahab who was a prostitute
- there is Ruth who was not but a Moabite

- in the gospel of Matthew on several occasions, people cry out to Jesus Him "the Son of David"

- two men who are blind cry out to the Son of David, asking Jesus to heal them Matthew 9:27 And as Jesus passed on from there, two blind men followed him, crying aloud, "Have on us, Son of David."
Matthew 20:30 And behold, there were two blind men sitting by the roadside, and when they heard that Jesus was passing by, they cried out, "Lord, have on us, Son of David!"
