### Five Sins that Destroy Love: 1 Peter 2:1-3 ESV

1 Peter 2:1-3 ESV

Therefore, rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind. <sup>2</sup> Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation, <sup>3</sup> now that you have tasted that the Lord is good.

#### Introduction

- certain words can sting and certain words can \_\_\_\_\_
- just to help us out with an illustration of this reality, I thought I would quote a song written by Tim Hawkins about what not to do if you want a happy marriage

*If you're a man who wants to live a long and happy life  
These are the things you don't say to your wife*

*Hey honey have you gained some weight?  
That dress you wear reminds me of my old girlfriend  
And where'd you get those shoes? I think they're pretty lame  
Would you stop talking 'cause I'm trying to watch the game  
I planned a hunting trip next week on your birthday  
I didn't ask you 'cause I knew it'd be OK  
Go make some dinner while I watch this fishing show  
I taped it over our old wedding video  
Your cooking is OK but not like mother makes  
The diamond in the ring I bought you is a fake  
Your eyes look puffy dear, are you feeling ill?  
Happy anniversary I bought you a treadmill*

- Peter in this passage reminds us of the language and \_\_\_\_\_ that can destroy unity and a loving environment in the body of Christ

1 Peter 1:22 Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart,

- in 1 Peter 2:1 we see attitudes and language that destroys love

1 Peter 2:1 So put away all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander.



## Review

- in 1 Peter 1:22-25, Peter \_\_\_\_\_ these believers of two important truths of the work of Jesus Christ for sinners
  - i) had their souls \_\_\_\_\_ by the blood of Christ and the sanctification of the Holy Spirit
  - ii) had been born again by the \_\_\_\_\_ of God, which is the gospel
- Peter then quotes from \_\_\_\_\_ 40:6-9, to remind them of the power of the word of God
- humanity will not \_\_\_\_\_, human ideas will not last but the word of the Lord will remain \_\_\_\_\_
- because the word of the Lord will remain forever, the \_\_\_\_\_ of God are sure and faithful
- the Lord will not \_\_\_\_\_ the promises found in His word

### 1) (2:1) Gut Your Life of Sin

**(2:1) So rid yourselves of all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all slander.**

- the “so” at the start of this section can also be translated as “\_\_\_\_\_”
- this “so” or “therefore” goes back to the previous section of 1 Peter 1: \_\_\_\_\_
- they are to “rid themselves” of these sins for these 5 reasons
  1. because they had been \_\_\_\_\_ by Jesus Christ and they were obedient to the gospel (1:22)
  2. because they \_\_\_\_\_ one another with a brotherly love (1:22)
  3. because they had been born again by the gospel of Jesus Christ (1:22)
  4. because they had preached to them the \_\_\_\_\_ and active word of God (1:25)
  5. because they had the gospel \_\_\_\_\_ to them (1:25)
- the phrase “rid themselves” means to “\_\_\_\_\_ off” or to “lay aside”
- of course, it has the idea of gutting out, meaning that you \_\_\_\_\_ the remaining sin from your life
- the word “rid” is used numerous times in the Bible to speak about \_\_\_\_\_ the sin in your life

Romans 13:12 The night is far gone; the day is at hand. So then let us \_\_\_\_\_ off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light.

Ephesians 4:22 to \_\_\_\_\_ off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires,

Ephesians 4:25 Therefore, having put \_\_\_\_\_ falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.

Colossians 3:8 But now you must put them all \_\_\_\_\_: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth.

- Peter gives us what people call a "vice list" which is a list of sins that we are to avoid

1. malice

2. deceit

Mark 14:1 It was now two days before the Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread. And the chief priests and the scribes were seeking how to arrest him by stealth (deceit) and kill him,

3. hypocrisy

4. envy

Exodus 20:17 "You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor's."

5. slander

Exodus 20:16 "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor."

## 2) (2:2) Grow in Your Salvation

(2:2) Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk,

- this does not mean that these believers who received 1 Peter were \_\_\_\_\_ Christians or babes in the faith

- Peter uses this imagery to remind them that they have been \_\_\_\_\_

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

- as a baby craves and longs for milk we are to \_\_\_\_\_ and long the pure spiritual milk of God

- this milk is described as “pure” and “spiritual” which points us to the word of God and the

- with this illustration, Peter is telling us something \_\_\_\_\_ about the Bible and the gospel
- just as an infant needs milk for life and growth, the Christian needs God’s word and the gospel of Jesus Christ so that they can \_\_\_\_\_ in their salvation
- if you are claiming to be a follower of Christ and not reading and studying the Bible, you are \_\_\_\_\_ your faith to death

Matthew 4:4 But he answered, "It is written, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God."

that by it you may grow up into salvation--

- by God’s pure and spiritual milk which is the gospel and the word of God, we can \_\_\_\_\_ to grow in the Lord
- God \_\_\_\_\_ us through the word of God
- God \_\_\_\_\_ us by the word of God through the Holy Spirit and then we realize that we \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus Christ and we trust in His work upon the Cross
- God reminds us by the word of God of the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ and God

James 1:21 Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

### 3) (2:3) Goodness of the Lord

(2:3) if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good.

Psalm 34:1-11 I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth. <sup>2</sup> My soul makes its boast in the LORD; let the humble hear and be glad. <sup>3</sup> Oh, magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together! <sup>4</sup> I sought the LORD, and he answered me and delivered me from all my fears. <sup>5</sup> Those who look to him are radiant, and their faces shall never be ashamed. <sup>6</sup> This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him and saved him out of all his troubles. <sup>7</sup> The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and delivers them. <sup>8</sup> Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good! Blessed is the man who takes refuge in him! <sup>9</sup> Oh, fear the LORD, you his saints, for those who fear him have no lack! <sup>10</sup> The young lions suffer want and hunger; but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing. <sup>11</sup> Come, O children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD.

- since these Christians have \_\_\_\_\_ the goodness of God, they ought to \_\_\_\_\_ the word of God and put to \_\_\_\_\_ sin



## Application

### 1) \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord Satisfies!

- if there is one certain reality, it is the reality that sin never satisfies
- because of sin, humans are \_\_\_\_\_ from God and there is nothing more unsatisfying than this truth
- furthermore, when we sin, this sin wages \_\_\_\_\_ against our souls and \_\_\_\_\_ the joy that we ought to have if we serve Christ
- sin \_\_\_\_\_ you from God
- the only \_\_\_\_\_ for the sorrow and the separation from God that sin brings is the person and work of \_\_\_\_\_ Christ

1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit,

- if you are \_\_\_\_\_ reconciled before God do not come to God trying to explain how good you have been
- the Lord \_\_\_\_\_ through it all
- instead, come before the Lord and \_\_\_\_\_ out to Jesus that He would give you mercy and grace!
- receive Christ and \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ and His wonderful work!

### 2) Do You \_\_\_\_\_ the Gospel and the Word of God?

- have you ever gone without food or water for more than a day?    Y    N
- have you ever gone without food or water for more than a week?    Y    N
- but have you ever gone an entire week without cracking your Bible?    Y    N
- have you gone months without attending church?    Y    N
- have neglected to hear the preaching of the word of God?    Y    N
- when you do this, you are certainly \_\_\_\_\_ yourself and you will not grow
- Christian, do you have a \_\_\_\_\_ for the word of God and are you getting into the word of God?
- if you have no desire for the word of God ----- ask God to \_\_\_\_\_ you a desire for His word
- then you need to \_\_\_\_\_ time each day to experience God and His goodness in His word

- hear how David loved the word of God in Psalm 119

Psalm 119:47 for I find my \_\_\_\_\_ in your commandments, which I love.

Psalm 119:48 I will lift up my hands toward your commandments, which I \_\_\_\_\_, and I will meditate on your statutes.

Psalm 119:97 Oh how I love your law! It is my meditation all the day.

- if you are struggling with getting into the Bible, make all of Psalm \_\_\_\_\_ your prayer!

### 3) Gut Sinful Words and Attitudes from Your Life

- \_\_\_\_\_ we look at gutting the sin from our lives we must look at our \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus Christ

- Jesus Christ has \_\_\_\_\_ us by grace alone and the Lord \_\_\_\_\_ His people with His grace and His presence

- just think of the most famous Psalm in the Bible, which is Psalm 23

Psalm 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not \_\_\_\_\_.

- the Lord \_\_\_\_\_ His people and this ought to motivate us to “gut” or “lay aside” or “put away” the \_\_\_\_\_ that so easily entangles us

- if you find yourself bubbling up with rage because of someone, \_\_\_\_\_ and seek the grace of Christ

- if you find yourself being envious because people have better stuff than you, then remind yourself of the wonderful \_\_\_\_\_ and joys in Christ

- when you are tempted to slander someone, remind yourself of the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord found in the Bible that offers you so much joy

- sin \_\_\_\_\_ satisfies, only the Lord satisfies
