1 Peter 2:1-3 FSV

Therefore, rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind. <sup>2</sup> Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation, <sup>3</sup> now that you have tasted that the Lord is good.

- this milk is described as "pure" and "spiritual" which points us to the word of God and the
<ul> <li>with this illustration, Peter is telling us something about the Bible and the gospel</li> <li>just as an infant needs milk for life and growth, the Christian needs God's word and the gospel of Jesus Christ so that they can in their salvation</li> </ul>
- if you are claiming to be a follower of Christ and not reading and studying the Bible, you areyour faith to death

Psalm 34:1-11 I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth. <sup>2</sup> My soul makes its boast in the LORD; let the humble hear and be glad. <sup>3</sup> Oh, magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together! <sup>4</sup> I sought the LORD, and he answered me and delivered me from all my fears. <sup>5</sup> Those who look to him are radiant, and their faces shall never be ashamed. <sup>6</sup> This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him and saved him out of all his troubles. <sup>7</sup> The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and delivers them. <sup>8</sup> Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good! Application 1) the Lord Satisfies!
- if there is one certain reality, it is the reality that sin never satisfies
- because of sin, humans arefrom God and there is nothing more unsatisfying than this truth
- furthermore, when we sin, this sin wagesagainst our souls and the joy that we ought to have if we serve Christ
- sin you from God
- the only for the sorrow and the separation from God that sin brings is the person and work of Christ
1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit,
<ul> <li>- if you are reconciled before God do not come to God trying to explain how good you have been</li> <li>- the Lord through it all</li> <li>- instead, come before the Lord and out to Jesus that He would give you mercy and grace</li> <li>- receive Christ and in Christ and His wonderful work!</li> </ul>
