

2 Peter 1:19-21: The Inspiration and Infallibility of the Scriptures

2 Peter 1:19-21 ESV

¹⁹ And we have the prophetic word more fully confirmed, to which you will do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts, ²⁰ knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation. ²¹ For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

Introduction

- John MacArthur in His book called "Final Word" says this about professing Christians that neglect the Word of God:

Some Christians undergo a frantic struggle every Sunday to remember where they last saw their Bibles. They know they had it with them at church last week. But they haven't seen it since they got home to set it down. Inevitably, they'll find it buried somewhere under the debris of the intervening week. And once the next Sunday rolls around, they will launch the same search to locate it again in time for its once-a-week use.

- another good Baptist, Charles Spurgeon, confronts Christians who neglect their Bible: Most people treat the Bible very politely. They have a small pocket volume, neatly bound; they put a white pocket-handkerchief around it, and carry it to their places of worship. When they get home, they lay it up in a drawer till next Sunday morning; then it comes out again for a little bit of a treat and goes to chapel; that is all the poor Bible gets in the way of an airing. That is your style of entertaining this Heavenly messenger. There is dust enough on some of your Bibles to write "damnation" with your fingers.

1) (1:19) Scripture Confirmed

(1:19) And we have the prophetic Word more fully confirmed,

a) Christ's life makes the Bible even more reliable

Genesis 3:15 I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."

Micah 5:2 But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days.

to which you will do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place,

b) pay attention to the light!

Psalm 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Psalm 119:130 The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.

2 Corinthians 4:6 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts,

c) until Jesus comes again!

Numbers 24:17 I see him, but not now; I behold him, but not near: a star shall come out of Jacob, and a scepter shall rise out of Israel; it shall crush the forehead of Moab and break down all the sons of Sheth.

2) (1:20) Scripture NOT from Man

knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation.

a) false prophets proclaim made up nonsense and lies

Jeremiah 14:14 And the LORD said to me: "The prophets are prophesying lies in my name. I did not send them, nor did I command them or speak to them. They are prophesying to you a lying vision, worthless divination, and the deceit of their own minds.

Ezekiel 13:3 Thus says the Lord GOD, Woe to the foolish prophets who follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing!

- b) true prophets' message is inspired and true
- 3) (1:21) Scripture Inspired by God

(1:21) For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man,

a) Bible is not contrived by man

but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

b) Bible is from God and is reliable

Acts 27:15 And when the ship was caught and could not face the wind, we gave way to it and were driven along.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, ¹⁷ that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.


Application

- 1) The Bible has the Words of Life
- a) the gospel in the OT
- **2 Peter 1:19** And we have the prophetic Word more fully confirmed, to which you will do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts,
- b) messianic prophecy fulfilled in NT

Acts 3:13-15 The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified his servant Jesus, whom you delivered over and denied in the

presence of Pilate, when he had decided to release him. ¹⁴ But you denied the Holy and Righteous One, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, ¹⁵ and you killed the Author of life, whom God raised from the dead. To this we are witnesses.

- c) trust in Christ the author of life
- 2) We Can Trust the Bible Because It Comes from God
- a) inspired and infallible
- b) a true and reliable Bible means 5 things:
 - 1) we can trust the Bible to be true and accurate
 - 2) we can have confidence in the promises of God
 - 3) we can believe all the historical content in the Bible
 - 4) we must acknowledge the authority of God's Word
 - 5) we must obey all the instructions given
- c) unreliable alternatives
- d) the voice of God in the Word of God
- **1 Corinthians 2:10-12** these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God. ¹¹ For who knows a person's thoughts except the spirit of that person, which is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. ¹² Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.
- 3) Love God by Loving His Word
- a) be in the Word of God
- **1 Peter 2:1-3** So put away all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander. ² Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation-- ³ if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good.



b) cultivate a hunger for the Word of God

c) pray for a desire

d) don't be apathetic
