

2 Peter 2:1-3 - Seven Truths About False Teachers

2 Peter 2:1-3 ESV

¹But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction. ²And many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of truth will be blasphemed. ³And in their greed they will exploit you with false words. Their condemnation from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep.

(2:1) But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you,

Deuteronomy 13:1-3 "If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder, ² and the sign or wonder that he tells you comes to pass, and if he says, 'Let us go after other gods,' which you have not known, 'and let us serve them,' ³ you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams. For the LORD your God is testing you, to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

d) warned by Paul
Acts 20:29-30 ²⁹ I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; ³⁰ and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them.

2) (2:1) False Teachers Will Act Deceptively
(2:1) who will secretly bring in destructive heresies

1 Peter 1:18-19 knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, ¹⁹ but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot.
4) (2:2) False Teachers Will Have Many Followers (2:2) And many will follow their sensuality
a) they are appealing


- i) sin has no consequence
- ii) indulge in sexual sin
- iii) easy believism
- b) Jesus confirms this

Matthew 7:13 "Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many.

5) (2:2) False Teachers Will Blaspheme the Truth

(2:2) and because of them the way of truth will be blasphemed.

- a) blasphemy disrespect
- b) slander mock



6) (2:3) False Teachers Will Be Greedy

(2:3) And in their greed they will exploit you with false words.

Jude 1:11 Woe to them! For they walked in the way of Cain and abandoned themselves for the sake of gain to Balaam's error and perished in Korah's rebellion.

7) (2:1, 3) False Teachers Will Be Judged

- (2:1) even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction.
- (2:3) Their condemnation from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep.

2 Peter 3:3-4 knowing this first of all, that scoffers will come in the last days with scoffing, following their own sinful desires. ⁴ They will say, "Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation."

Application

1) There is A Danger if You Deny Jesus

a) danger: have nothing of eternal value

2 Peter 2:1even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction.

Colossians 1:15-20 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. ¹⁶ For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities-- all things were created through him and for him. ¹⁷ And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. ¹⁸ And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent. ¹⁹ For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, ²⁰ and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.

- Jesus Christ purchases freedom by His blood as 2 Peter 2:1 says "the Master who bought them"
- b) danger: are in bondage

Mark 10:45 For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

- c) danger: are a captive facing judgement
- d) danger: will face judgement
